Getting Started with WordPress: A Step-by-Step Tutorial Using BlueHost

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#### Section One: Getting Ready...

You we heard everyone tell you that you ought to set up your new business site with WordPress. You vaguely know it has something to do with bloggingí but what exactly is it?

õWordPressö actually refers to three separate entitiesí

Only one of these three completely different WordPress types allows you to actually host a blog for free. That is WordPress.com. But should you host your blog there?

#### Web Hosting

It is not a good idea to create a free blog at WordPress.com if you is planning to monetize your blog content in any way (displaying ads, sending people to your sales page, including affiliate links and the like) of or even use it for business. For one thing, this is against WordPress.com rules.

If you disregard these rules, you are quite likely to wake up one morning and find out your blog has disappeared off the face of the digital planet, without a word of explanation. And all your hard work has gone up in smoke for some violation that will never get explained.

Your best solution? <u>Host your WordPress blog on your own domain!</u> (Yes, you can absolutely use the WordPress CMS if you dongt host your blog on WordPress.com.)

#### **Choosing a Domain Name**

Be sure, however, to choose a strong Domain name (either your own name, a catchy business name you want to brand, or an easy-to-pronounce-and-remember keyword and/or location based name; for example: õchicagocloggingclub.comö). (Yes, õccc.comö would be shorter, catchier and easier to brand and remember ó but that will only work if you want people *who already know that acronym* to find you.)

#### **Registering Your Domain Name**

Hereøs another common area of confusion, for people who are new to running their own blog or site: Domain registration.

Your domain is your home on the net. For example, say your name is Ray Bandana: You might pay a web hosting company to host õ<u>www.raybandana.com</u>ö for you.

Your domain URL (address) sits on your web hostøs massive server computer. That is its home. But hereøs where people get a little confused: The person who registers your domain can either be your web hosting company (e.g. <u>BlueHost</u>) or *Hostgator*. We use HOSTGATOR BUTí <u>.\*\*\*\* PLEASE GO TO THE LAST PAGE OF THIS MANUAL RIGHT NOW!</u> <u>Read Hostgator vs. BlueHost</u>

You dong have to choose either of course: You can pick and choose any web hosting company. ó but whichever one you use, just make sure that the company is WordPress-friendly.

Whichever company you choose, make sure it has **cPanel** (a control panel), and supports **PHP**, **MySQL5** (or the latest version of MySQL) and **WordPress** ó and, finally, that it supports either **Fantastico DeLuxe or Simple Scripts**.

If you cangt find the information you need on the sign-up page, look for a õFeaturesö tab:



Bottom line: There are many types of web hosting companies ó and not all are ideal for blogging!

#### **Unlimited Domains**

If you are planning to host more than one website or blog for your business, do choose a web host that offers unlimited domains: It is better for internet searchability to have each URL (domain address; e.g. <u>owww.whateveryouwant.com</u>;) in its own separate domain, rather than as an <u>oadd-on</u>; domain or <u>osub-domain</u>.

If each site is in an entirely separate domain, it can also be transferred, should you ever decide to sell it. (Note: You will have to purchase (register) each new domain name as you add these ó either from BlueHost or from your chosen Domain registration company.)

Most reliable web hosting companies offer one free domain registration with your sign up, so there is no need for a separate registration: However, if your business model **includes multiple domains**, it will definitely be cheaper ó after signing up with your web host and letting them register your primary free domain ó to register all your other domains with a company such as <u>Dynadot</u> that specializes in domain registration.

<u>A word of caution</u>: Most domain registration companies will offer amazingly cheap web hosting (or even free web hosting). I would not recommend using your domain registration company for webhosting: Often your site will be laced with ads you dongt know about or they provide poor support, obscure documentation or frequent õsit downö problems ó as well as bandwidth limitations.

(You really dongt want to sign up and discover your new web host doesngt have a cPanel, doesngt support the MySQL databasing needed for WordPress, and wants you to upgrade to their \$179.95 per year plan because yougwe exceed your 15mb bandwidthí in the first week!)



By all means use Domain registration companies for **easy multiple and single domain registration** and **inexpensive domain transfers**, however.

Now let set WordPress installed, and set up your blogí

#### **Preparing to Install WordPress**

There are many guides showing you how to set up WordPress using the Fantastico DeLuxe script, so we're going to do something a little different. We're going with Hostgator's quick install or <u>BlueHost</u>, a company that uses <u>Simple Scripts</u>.



Those used to Fantastico are going to want to over-complicate things when changing over to a company that uses *Simple Scripts*. Dongt do it! It really is a simple process ó but not if you start

trying to dot every õiö and cross every õtö. If you¢re into micro-controlling every step, stick with Fantastico: If, on the other hand, you want simple õone-clickö processes, Simple Scripts will probably suit you better.

Sign up is easy, and you¢l find yourself looking at your cPanel in no time at all. This is what it will look like. If a popup doesn¢t appear, you can access the introductory õGetting Startedö wizard (under õPreferencesö) for **tutorials, demos** and **videos**. For example, if you want to see how easy it is to set up a new email account ó something that traditionally has been known to give even seasoned bloggers nightmares ó watch the BlueHost video in the õGetting Startedö wizard.



<u>**Do NOT**</u> watch the video for installing WordPress, however: If you follow the instructions, you may end up with the following error message:

If this happens, you have two choices:

- 1. Contact Tech Support and ask them to fix it for you and set up your blog. (They will: And all you will have to do is make note of the log-in information and password, log in, and proceed straight to õSection Three: Customizing your Blogö, skimming over the next few pages.)
- **2.** If you prefer more control, or want to know what to do the next time you want to add a blog, simply follow the instructions below. (Yes. In spite of the error message.)

The following method has worked for me every time ó even after I have asked Tech Support to õnukeö my account and bring it back to brand-new, empty status.

#### Section Two: How to Install Simple Scripts and Quickly Set Up WordPress

1. Find the õSite Buildersö tab and select the WordPress icon.



2. The Simple Scripts page will open up. Find the õBlogsö section and select õWordPressöí

3. The õInstall WordPressö window will open. Click on the õInstallö button.



A new page will open up, and you will see your WordPress site being built.

As soon as the Site URL and Login URL for your blog appears, even if it still says õIn Progressö, you can (a) copy-paste your auto-generated password and (b) click on your Login URL to access your new blog.



**4.** Enter õadminö under õUsernameö and paste your Password into the õPasswordö field. Click the blue õLog Inö button:



5. You should then see your new dashboard. Ignore all the stuff under the õWelcomeö messageí .



We are only going to use your left-hand, vertical Dashboard controls.


We are going to go through only the tabs where you need to customize data for maximum searchability. First, let@s take care of your õSettingsö sectioní

#### Settings>>General

Select õ<u>*General Settings*</u>ö from the drop-down list that appears. Now is when you can change your site or blog **Title**, if you wish.

Select your õTaglineö ó your motto, slogan or a short description of what readers can expect.

(What you input in your Site Title and Tagline is what your readers will see. Like thisí )

All of your other default settings in õGeneral Settingsö should be as you want them, except for **Timezone**. (You will want to change your UTC code.)

If you dongt know your UTC code, simply press the drop-down button and select your city from the (alphabetical) drop-down list that will appear. Select it, and your correct UTC code will also be selected (but it wongt appear until after yougve Saved and refreshed).

If you wish, you can also change the way you want the date to appear in your posts from five separate formatsí



When youøre done altering your general settings, press the blue õSave Changesö button



#### Settings>>Discussion

Close õGeneral Settingsö. Go back to your õSettingsö tab and select õDiscussionö.



When your õDiscussionö page opens, all you need to do there is click on õ<u>*Turn comments on or*</u> <u>off</u>ö to toggle this setting to your preference.

BlueHost has excellent SEO defaults, which you may not wish to change: However, as you can see, it a easy to do so, if you wish. The default is to allow people to comment ó simply uncheck it if you want no comments at all.

The only other recommended change: <u>*Put "Newer" comments at the top rather than "Older"* (this is what people expect).</u>

Slide on down to õ<u>*Avatars*</u>ö to set your preferences. I would recommend õGravatarsö, if you want peoplesøProfile photos to appear; or else õMystery Manö. (Don¢t bother with the cutesy Wavatars, etc., unless your audience is under twenty.)

Save your changes!



Fill in your profile. The only two sections youd want to pay attention to:

1. õ*Display name publicly*ö ó the name you want your public to see.

#### Settings>>Writing

The õWritingö tab has only one modification you need to make. Slide right down to the bottom of that section and find the Textarea box with the single, solitary, lonely little õpingomaticö pingback link:



#### **Plugins**

Next, go to your Plugins tab in your left-hand, vertical menu. The only already-installed plugin that you absolutely MUST activate is Akismet, your spam filter.



If you already have an Akismet API key, click on õActivateö, then click on õEnter your Akismet API keyö and enter it in the Textarea box provided. (If you don¢t, click on õSign up for an Akismet API keyö.)

Youd be given the key ó a serial number. In fact, it should already be populating the Textarea box when you Activate it:

Dongt add the mobile plugins until yougve (later) customized your theme. Once yougve got your theme looking the way you want, then you can return and add these mobile plugins, if you wish them activated. Meanwhile, dongt overload your blog with plugins. Stick to the essentials. After Akismet, these are:

- All in One SEO Pack
- Google XML Sitemaps
- Theme Authenticity Checker (TAC)
- Sociable (or any other social bookmarking plugin you prefer)
- WP Security Scan



You can find each of these at WordPress.org in its õPluginsö section ó right from your Dashboard! Simply Go back to õPluginsö and select the õAdd Newö tab. Then enter the name of the plugin you wish to find into the Textarea box, and press õSearch pluginsö.

Select õInstall Nowö. A page will open up, letting you know if the Install was successful. Click on õActivate Pluginö.



Note: That *is* all there is to it for some plugins. Others will have a õSettingsö link or present you with a message such as this one:



Click on the link provided and configure or input settings as instructed. This usually includes:

- Sliding over any advertising to click on õEnableö or õActivateö buttons
- Entering Titles, Descriptions, Summaries as instructed
- Entering hard data requested, such as your Google Analytics ID

Once you are satisfied with your plugins, it is time to change your blog appearance from the default theme to a custom theme that best befits your needs.

Make sure you Save by pressing õUpdate Optionsö.

#### Appearance

To change your Theme, go to the õAppearanceö tab in the left-hand, vertical menu and press it. A selection of three basic themes will open up. You can find more themes at the WordPress.org <u>Themes</u> section, or you can purchase a paid Premium Theme such as the highly flexible and easy <u>Socrates</u> theme; but whatever you do, be very careful of indiscriminately downloading and trying õfreeö themes from randomly-Googled sites. Many of these are laced with hidden code that will undermine or even harm your site.


Letøs start the **SmallBiz**ö theme offered in your Appearances screen. A full-screen page will open up, showing you how your blog will look (without your personal data ó this is just a Layout example).

If you like it, select õSave & Activateö:



The next page that opens up allows you to thoroughly customize your new SmallBiz theme, as well as watch a video explaining its features. Don¢t do this part unless you have some time to go through all the settings and features. It will likely take a little time to tweak your settings, text and colors until youøve got them the way you like them ó until then, the sample text displays.

And if you¢e anxious to get started blogging, simply stay with (or go back to and re-activate) the **Twenty Ten** theme or **Twenty Eleven** for now: You can start adding posts right away ó and search for the theme of your choice later. (Note that even these basic themes allow you to perform actions like upload a custom Header or pick a new one from the õAppearancesö drop-down menu.)



#### Section Three: Getting to Know Your Blog

The first thing youd want to do is add a post (and change any default post, if there is one). Go to your left-hand, vertical menu and select õPosts>>All Postsö.

The default õHello Worldö post will open up. Replace the Title with your own and the text with your own.

Remember to slide down to your All in one SEO boxes and fill in your blog post Title, Description (less than 160 characters) and Keywords ó as well as any Tags you want to flag the article with. This will help your postø searchability greatly.

Finally ó Press the blue õUpdateö button on the top, right-hand side of the page.

And that *ø*s the basic process in setting up a WordPress blog (except for selecting õAdd Newö next time in õPostsö, rather than õAll Postsö).

#### **Editing Your HTML URLs**

Another thing you may want to do: Edit your post URLs for more searchability. It a very simple process ó just press the õEditö button and write in your new page URL, exactly as you d like it to appear.

(Remember to press the õOkayö button when you¢re finished.)

#### **Adding Images**

Photographs and graphics give your posts (and blog) massively more searchability and eye appeal ó so do get into the habit of inserting at least one, per post.

The best idea for image sources: Take your own photographs. Failing that, only use photographs in the public domain (with public domain licensing) or ask permission to use photos.

(Government websites and Wikipedia are often a great source of public domain photographs: Do still check the licensing, however ó sometimes government photos do have licensing restrictions.)

Pressing the õ<u>Add Media</u>ö button will open up a popup allowing you to add photos from your blog library (once you have one), your computer or from another URL, if you have a photo parked on another site. (Do NOT use the latter option if you don¢t own the site or if you¢re not directly invited to do so: You might end up inadvertently õstealingö bandwidth from the site owner.)



View your post from the edit buttons, or else from the õView Siteö at the top left corner of your Dashboard.

#### **Static Page or Latest Post?**

But ó whoops! Why does your first page not show the post?

Go to õSettings>>Readingö and change õFront page displaysö option from õA static pageö to õYour latest postsö by pressing the radio button.

If you¢d rather make your first post into a static page (a õHomeö page all visitors will see every time they visit your site) keep õA static pageö selected, and select the correct post from the drop-down menu
