They are more expensive than re-usables You need to buy them frequently They take up space in your shopping cart They take up storage space in your home

At home:

- ✓ A washcloth or face flannel is perfect for little hands and faces
- ✓ Mop up using re-usable cloths / old t-shirts
- ✓ Keep old or frayed towels to mop up big spills
- Clean windows and mirrors with vinegar and old newspapers, pillow cases or shirts.

Restaurants:

- ✓ Don't use paper napkins— bring your own or use a handkerchief
- ✓ Buying take-away food from your local restaurant to eat at home? Bring your own containers and don't accept paper napkins, condiments, sauces, utensils or cutlery.





- ✓ Pull out only one single paper towel.
- ✓ Remember the video:- shake, fold!
